

1 Bois d'arc Tree

The bois d'arc tree's fruit is in the shape of a ball and is called a horse apple.

2 Live Oak Tree

Live oak trees have long curving limbs that may reach the ground.

3 Cottonwood Tree

Cottonwood trees often grow near water. When the wind blows through their leaves, it sounds like rain falling.

4 Cedar Tree

The cedar tree is evergreen.

5 Squirrels

Look and listen for squirrels in trees. They make chattering sounds.

6 Blue Jay

Blue Jays love to eat acorns, which are the nuts from oak trees.

7 Cardinal

Cardinal males are red and females are light brown.

8 Mockingbird

Mockingbirds are gray and white, and very vocal.

9 Bees

Look for bees on flowers. Native bees pollinate most flowering plants.

10 Ladybug

Ladybugs are a type of beetle. They eat many insects.

11 Sulfur Butterfly

Sulfur butterflies are yellow.

12 Buckeye Butterfly

The buckeye butterfly has round spots on its wings that look like eyes. They scare away predators.

13 Cutleaf Daisy or Engelmann's Daisy

The Engelmann's daisy's leaves look like their sides were cut out with scissors.

14 Pink Evening Primrose

The pink evening primrose's nectar is especially favored by bees and moths

15 Indian Blanket

Indian Blanket's brilliant colors of red, orange and yellow look like the brightly-colored, woven blankets created by American Indians of the Southwest U.S.A.

16 Milkweed

Look for plants with white flower clusters that are round like a baseball.

17 Poison Ivy

Leaves of three, let them be!

18 Prairie Grass

Grasses are plants with long narrow leaves.

19 Bluebonnet

The bluebonnet is the state flower of Texas.

20 Ant

Look for ants on the trail. There are many different types of ants.

21 Pill Bug or Rolly Poly or Doodle Bug

Its shell looks like armor.

22 Snails

Snails carry their home on their backs.

23 Brush Pile

Brush piles are piles of tree branches that provide a place for animals to hide and to find food.

24 Coombs Creek

The water in Coombs Creek flows into the Trinity River and on to the Gulf of Mexico.
