

1 Squirrel

Look and listen for squirrels in trees. They make chattering sounds.

2 Indian Blanket

Indian Blanket's brilliant colors of red, orange and yellow look like the brightly-colored, woven blankets created by American Indians of the Southwest U.S.A.

3 Milkweed

Look for plants with white flower clusters that are round like a baseball.

4 Bee

Look for bees on flowers. Native bees pollinate most flowering plants.

5 Live Oak Tree

Live oak trees have long curving limbs that reach the ground.

6 Prairie Grass

Grasses are plants with long narrow leaves.

7 Cottonwood Tree

Cottonwood trees often grow near water. When the wind blows through their leaves, it sounds like rain falling.

8 Blue Jay

Blue Jays love to eat acorns, the nuts from oak trees.

9 Ant

Look for ants on the trail. There are many different types of ants.
